



In maths this week we have been refining efficient methods of long multiplication and then applying this to word problems. Ask your child to show you using any of the below calculations:


- 1) 13×17






We are looking forward to our visit to the Natural History Museum on the 5th March. Please keep your eye out for the letter regarding this and get it back to school ASAP to confirm your place!


If any parents are available to help that day, we would be very grateful. Please let Mary, Cheryl, Sarah or Clare know.
