Recently, in maths, we have been looking at fractions, decimals and percentages. It is important that the children learn common equivalents eg;

0.1, 10%, 1/10

0.5, 50%, 1/2

0.25, 25%, 1/4

0.2, 20%, 1/5

Monday 23rd January – Life Cycle of Humans

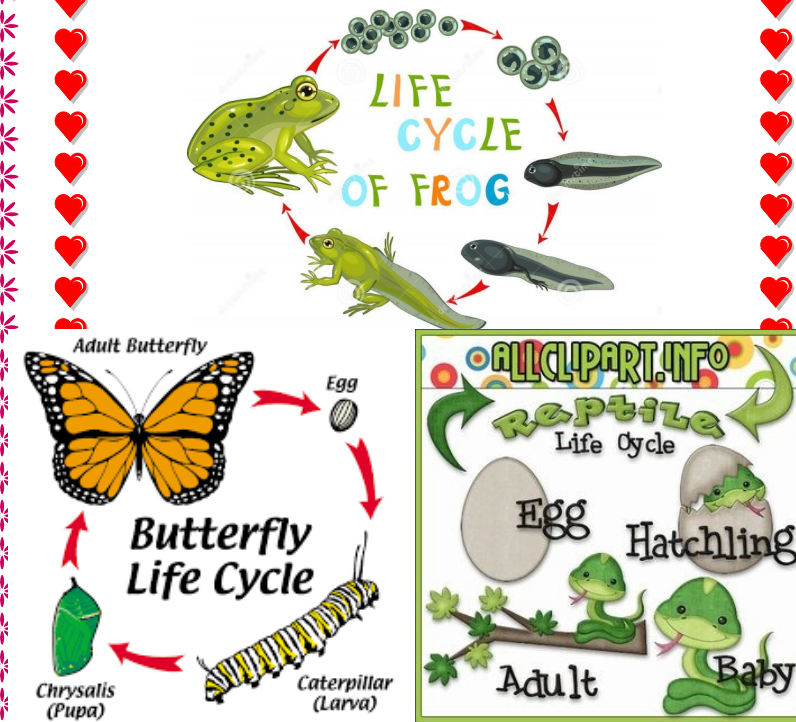
Tuesday 24th January – Boy and Girl Puberty Video (together).
