



# Just to let you know...

To reflect on the year and for learning journals, we got the children to have a go at writing their own reports. It was impressive to see how accurate a lot of them were in terms of how they feel about their strengths and areas for development.



In topic this week we launched our LEAPs; the theme is Guildford and after working in teams to mindmap potential project ideas, the children chose the areas which most interested them. They were then put into small groups to start thinking about: what they would like to find out, how they will find their information, who might be able to help, whether they could do a trip, what their WOW activity would be and finally, how they would present their findings. Topics which the children have chosen include: Guildford Castle, Guildford Cathedral, Lewis Carroll, The Guildhall, The Wey Navigations and Dapdune Wharf, The Lido, The Spike plus many more!
