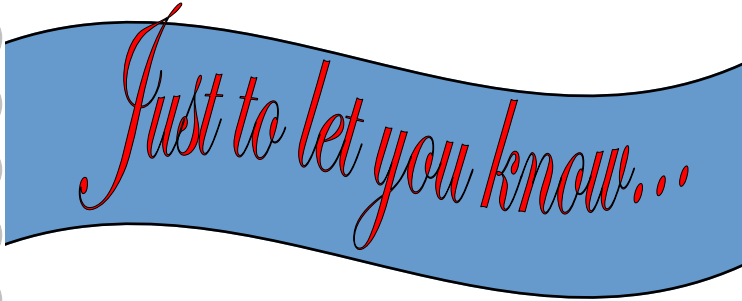


HOMEWORK ACTIVITIES

MATHS- The children are again bringing home their maths books to complete unfinished work.

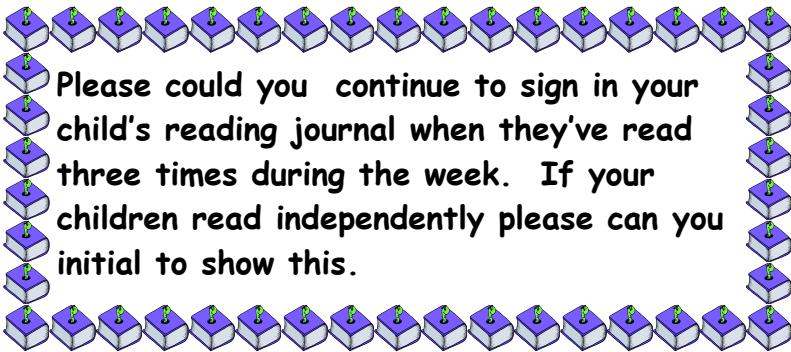
There is also a *mathletics* activity on percentages to complete.
