Have a go at thinking of creative ways to transport water from one place to another!

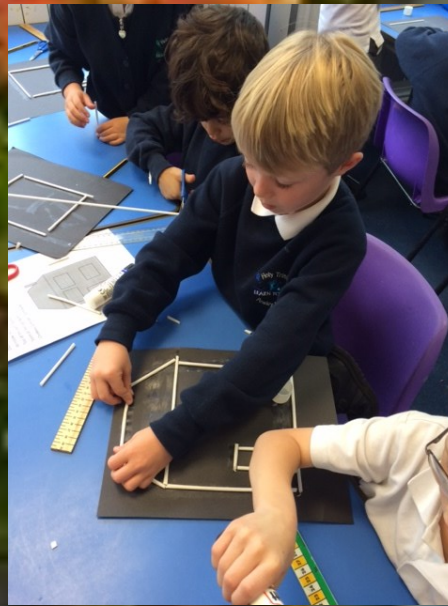
### Help needed!

## This week...

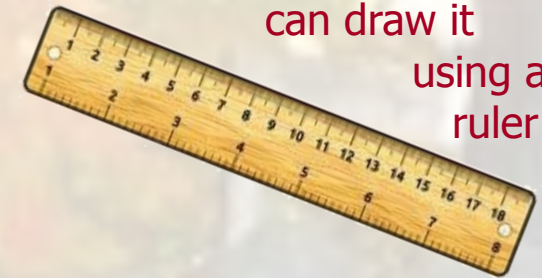
