This week we have been focussing on verbs and adverbs. You might like to try a verb charade game at home. Simply put a range of simple verbs into a hat, pull out and act the verb. Get others to guess what you are acting out and to suggest alternative verbs!

Maths

We have been multiplying numbers by 10 and 100. The children used place value charts to map out how numbers move up the scale when multiplied by 10 and 100. We have also recapped on symmetry reminding the children that many shapes have more than one line of symmetry.
