


Maths

We have been learning about multiplication this week and have practised talking about lots of, groups of, times, and multiplying. E.g. 4 lots of 5 is the same as 4 groups of 5 or 4 times 5 and the answer is 20. We have learnt to draw an array which is a drawing to represent multiplication. E.g



$$4 \times 5 = 20$$

At home, can you draw arrays and groups to multiply two chosen numbers (less than 10) e.g. 2×7 , 3×4 etc.
