The class trips to Henley Fort are on the following dates:

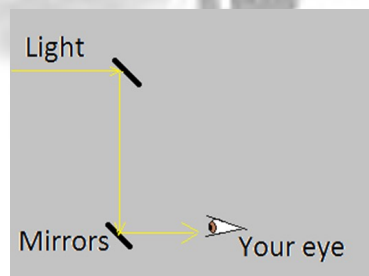
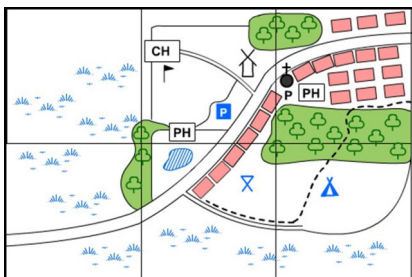
3T—Monday 14th May, 3S—Tuesday 15th May, 3A Wednesday 16th May.

Maths

In Maths this week we have been focusing on measuring accurately in cm and mm. We will move on to measuring the perimeter of shapes next week.

English

This week the children have continued to write their letters home as an evacuee, focusing on feelings, sounds and emotions. They learned how to create more complex sentences as well as continuing to use adverbs and conjunctions.

Geography

During Geography we learnt about plan and oblique views. We matched pictures and drew objects as a plan view as well as identifying OS map symbols. The children drew their own maps of Westbourne Village as part of our 'Spywatch' topic.

Science

We have been learning all about light. We found out that light travels in straight lines and can be reflected using a mirror. We were able to reflect a beam of light around a maze using mirrors. We found out that the angle the light hits the mirror (angle of incidence) is the same as the angle it bounces off (angle of reflection).
