Swimming will begin on Wednesday 15th April for 10 weeks.

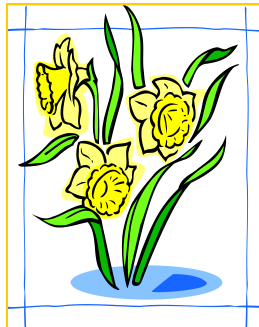
