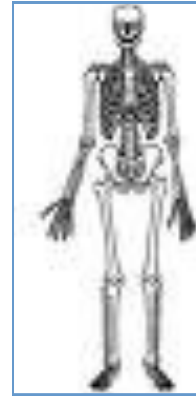
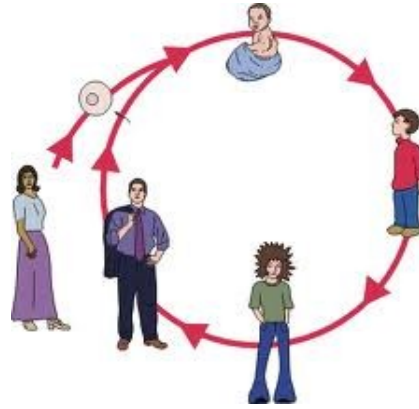

Bonus Words: nutrition reproduction processes

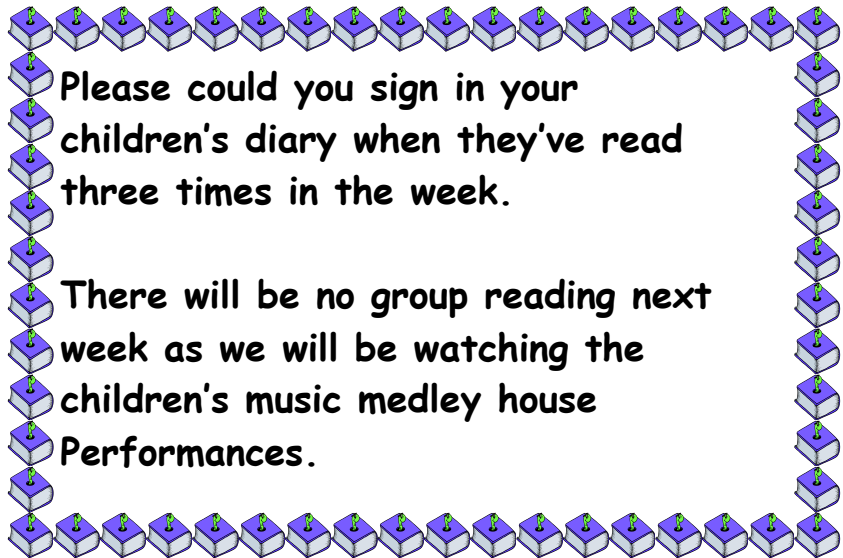
Just to let you know...
