

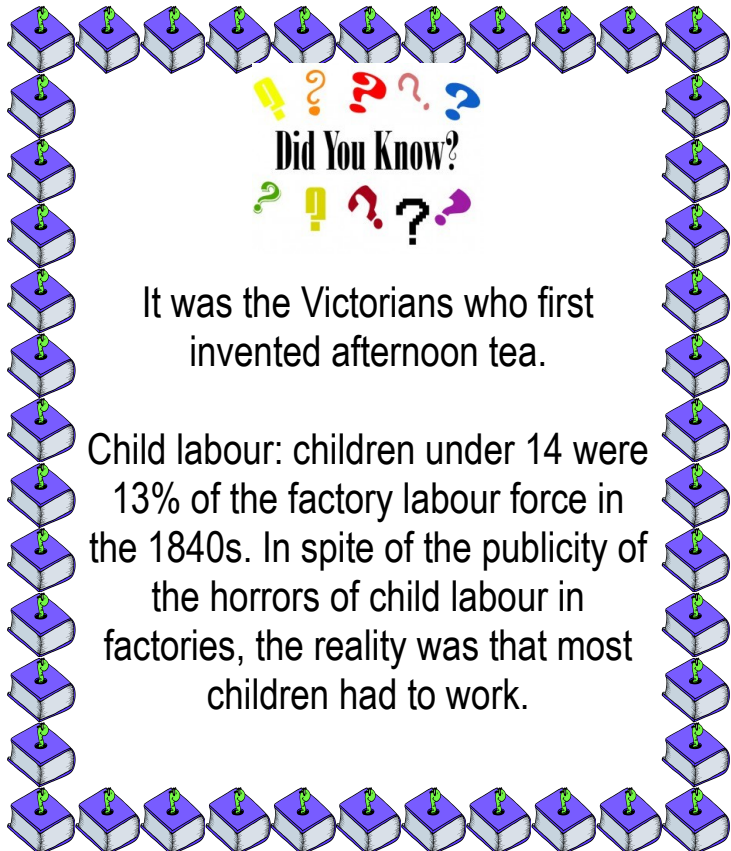

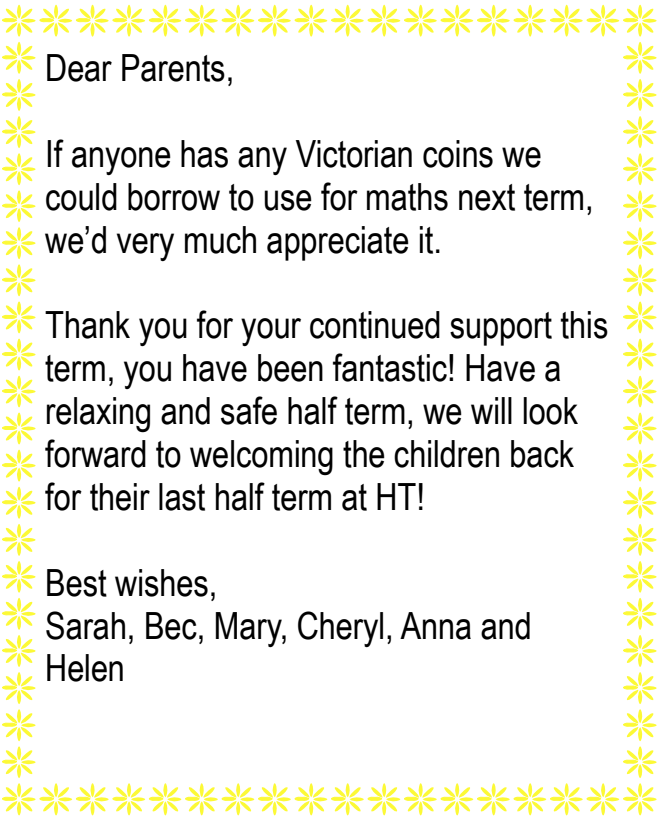

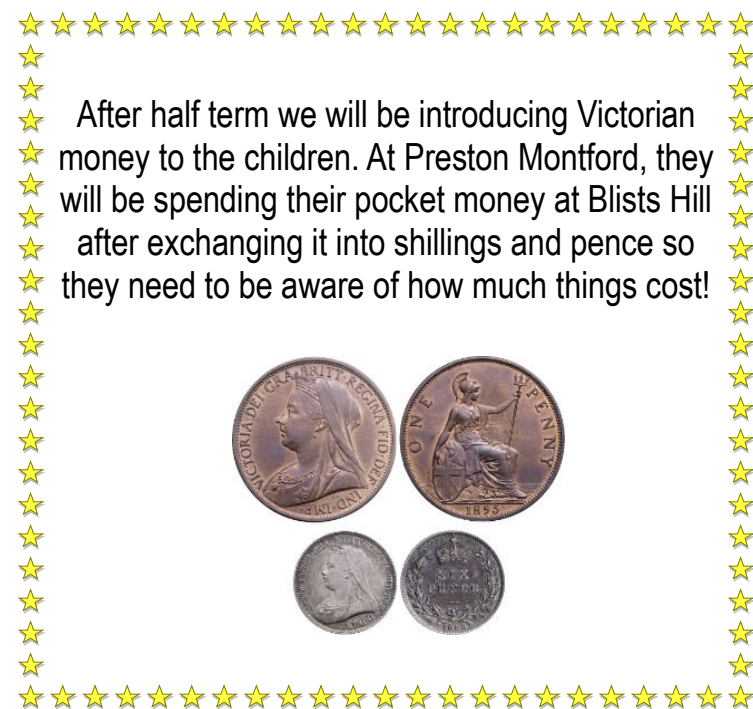


Dear Parents,
