Spelling Information

This week we have changed the format of our spellings slightly, reducing the number to eight per week, plus two spellings that the children find tricky and are able to choose for themselves. These are words they have spelt incorrectly in their writing.

Hopefully, you've had a copy of an activity sheet that gives ideas as to how to practise spellings in a variety of ways. This week, why not try:

Headlines: Cut letters out of a newspaper to spell your words. Glue them onto a piece of paper.

Extension: Two words of their choice that they find tricky in their own work.

In maths this week we have been using arrays (grouping) and the bus stop method of division.
