



Heads Up

Maths: In maths we'll be going back to fractions and thinking about adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominators and denominators with multiples of the same number. We'll be using the bar model to help us do this. E.g.:



Use a bar model to solve the calculations:

$$\frac{3}{8} + \frac{3}{8} \quad \frac{5}{6} + \frac{1}{6} \quad \frac{5}{3} + \frac{5}{3}$$

English: We'll be researching endangered animals and putting our 'campaigns' together. These consist of posters, leaflets and speeches. In case your child wanted to research this weekend, they have been told which animals their table's animal.

Topic: Thinking back to Hokusai, we'll be using his work as a stimulus to create our own drawings that will form a print that we'll make over the coming weeks. We'll be looking at them of 'water' and 'waves' to help us.

RE: Last week we thought about the choices that we can make and what consequences these can have. On Wednesday we'll be learning about the Early Church and thinking about what their priorities were - sharing the gospel - and how these priorities are shared by Christians today.
