

Children will have spellings to learn as always—we are on week 6 now.




In maths this week, we have been studying the properties of triangles, finding missing angles on a straight line, finding missing angles in polygons and revising 2D shape.

Ask your child to explain the following words:  
**Obtuse, acute, reflex, isosceles, scalene, right angle, equilateral, quadrilateral, regular shape**  
And see if they can work out what are the interior angles of a **regular hexagon**:



Please continue to read regularly, asking questions about the text. The children need practice explaining what words or phrases mean and why an author may have chosen them.
