Maths

We are practising quick recall of numbers facts to 10, 20 and 100 ,particularly pairs of numbers that are not multiples of 10 e.g. $43 + 57 = 100$

The children have enjoyed 'Beat the clock ' challenges on individual whiteboards.

We have been learning strategies to add near multiples of 10 e.g. 9, 11 19 and 21 and showing our steps on a number line.

This will help their mental maths skills.
