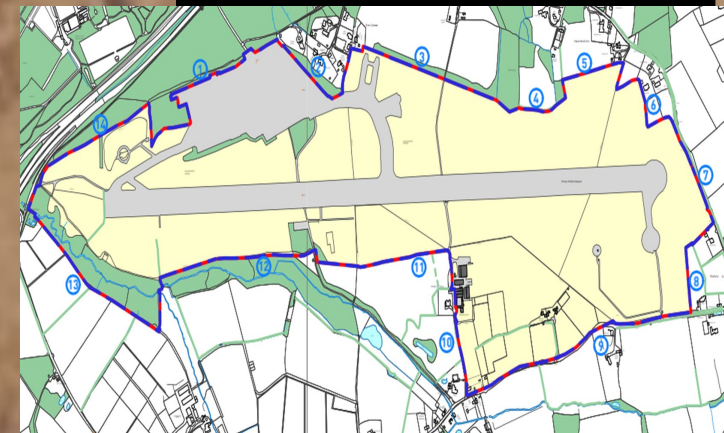
## Homework
