## Maths

In maths we have been looking at ratio and proportion.

It would be great if you could look at recipes or free offers (for every two products we buy, we receive one free. What would happen if we bought 8 products or how many would we have paid for to get 4 free?) and ask questions that allow them to understand the practical application of ratio.

Here is a recipe for 9 large cupcakes.

110g/4oz butter or margarine, softened at room temperature

110g/4oz caster sugar

2 free-range eggs, lightly beaten

1 tsp vanilla extract

110g/4oz self-raising flour

1-2 tbsp milk

What would they need for 3 cupcakes, 18 cupcakes, 45 cupcakes etc?
