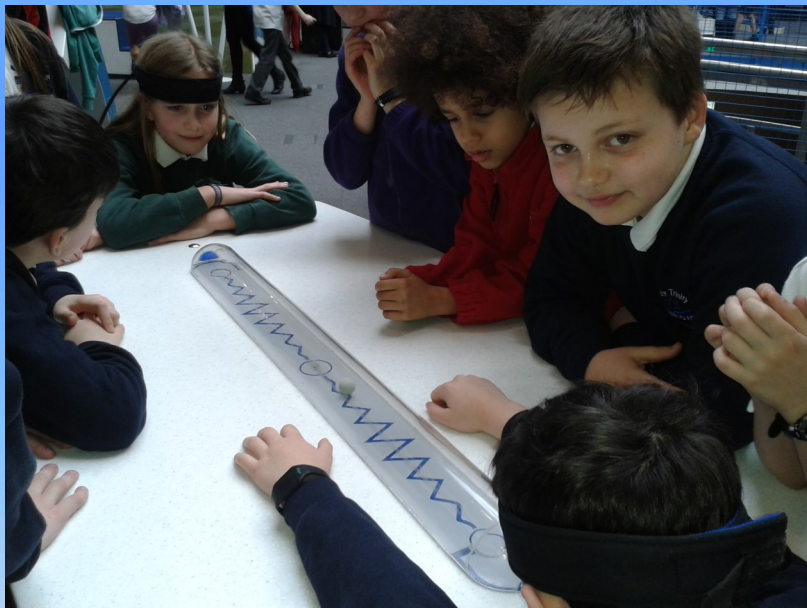


Literacy

The children have started the week by presenting their persuasive writing pieces to the class, persuading NASA to take them on a mission to Mars! The presentations showed that the children had really thought about different persuasive devices. They then went on to explore the different features of information texts. Using all they had learnt from their trip to Winchester Science Museum and their Science investigations, the children then went on to plan and create their own information texts.

Numeracy

This week all classes have been working really hard solving a whole range of one and two step word problems. These have involved subtraction, addition, multiplication and division. They have been able to unpack the information and choose the appropriate operation. All children are now recording their working far more systematically and checking their calculations by using the inverse.
