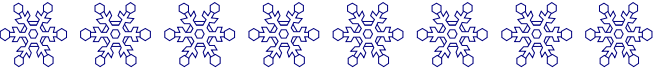


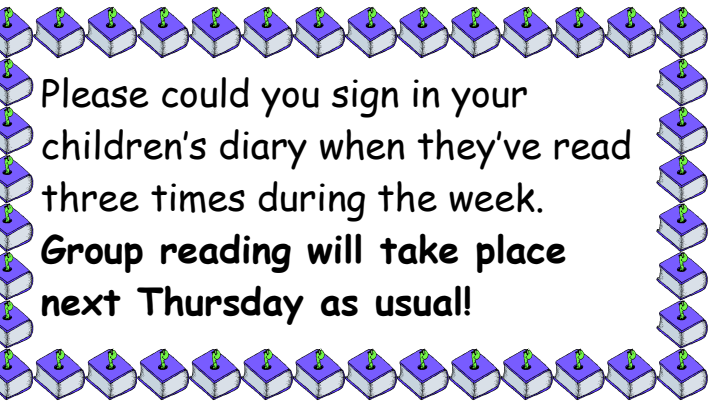
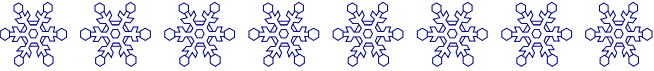
# Just to let you know...

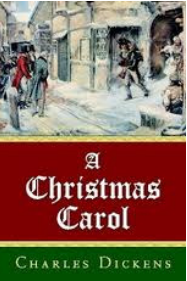


**Spellings:** dejected, desolate, disconsolate, miserable, despondent, wretched, melancholy, disheartened, dreary, debilitating
