Curriculum

All three classes have had wonderful times and great learning experiences at Henley Fort. Despite extremely inclement weather everyone had a fantastic time getting involved with drill, learning about gas masks, shelters, camouflage and disguise.

'How we used to Live', this week was all about the influence of the American GIs arriving in 1942. The children have worked hard writing up all that they have learnt. We have started looking at the features of informal letter writing, so they can then start thinking about the letter they will write as an evacuee.

In maths we are working on analogue, digital and 24hr clock, looking at time tables and lengths of time. In class maths we are measuring the Victory Gardens and the children are designing their own.
