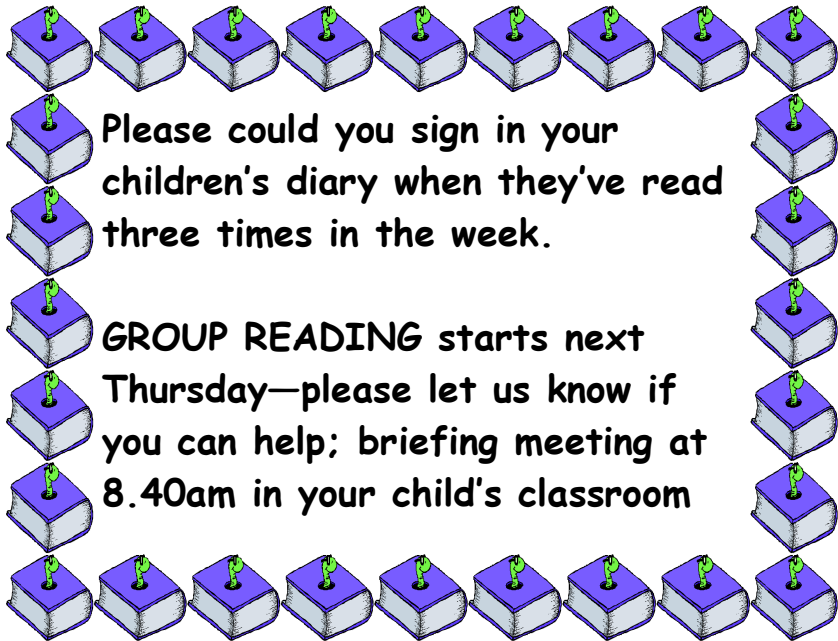


Bikeability Group 2 Sessions start on Tuesday at 1pm
