Maths

The children had a great start to the week in maths. We focused on using the 10 times table to work out the 9 and 11 times tables. The children progressed to using this multiplication strategy on large numbers.

Literacy

The topic was off to a great start with the children designing their own flat evacuee. They then analysed the features of an informal letter and wrote their own letter to send with their evacuee.
