Maths Corner

We have been practicing partitioning numbers into different combinations of tens and units.

E.g. $43 = 40 + 3$

$43 = 30 + 14$ $43 = 20 + 23$ etc.

We have also had fun estimating and measuring. The children are getting good at this! Try measuring using centimetres and metres. Can you work out the difference between two lengths in cm? e.g. If my foot is 20cm and you foot is 15cm, how much longer is my foot?
