#### **Maths:**

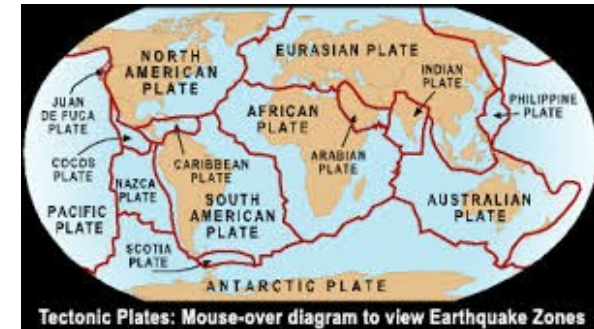
This week we have been investigating multiplication and the related division facts. Drawing arrays has helped the children understand and make links between the different number sentences.

#### **English:**

This week we have been learning about imperative (bossy) verbs. The children have been looking at instructions in different formats e.g. DIY manuals, recipes etc. Can your child give you an example of an imperative verb?

#### **Geography:**

The children enjoyed mapping out all of the active volcanoes on a world map. They then drew the Earth's tectonic plates onto tracing paper to reveal that the volcanoes were found near tectonic plate boundaries.
