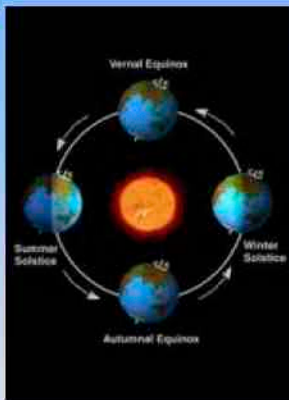


Just to let you know...

In topic this week the children have been researching day, night and seasons in order to teach year 3 children. To help understand how it all works, the children re-enacted the movement of the earth and moon in relation to the sun. A good website to have a look at is:

The spelling rule this week is adding the suffix 'ing', 'ed' and 'en', looking at long and short vowel sounds to determine how the ending is affected. There will be a little test on Monday.
