Sound of the Week

This week we have been learning the 'ay' sound as an alternate to 'ai' and 'a_e'. This has linked in with our maths work as we have been writing the days of the week. It's lovely to see so many of the children completing their challenges. We are running out of stickers!

Maths focus

This week we have been thinking about Time. We have been ordering the days of the week and reading o'clock and half past on a clock. Have a go at spotting as many 'o'clocks' or 'half pasts' on your clock at home throughout the day! Can you solve problems involving time?

Next week we will be revisiting subtraction, reminding ourselves of the ways we can solve problems. We will be challenging the children to have lightning quick recall of number facts to 10, 20 and 100.
