Literacy: We have been experiencing Greek life in Year 3 this week. On Tuesday and Wednesday the children got to find out what life might have been like in a Greek Agora. They tasted some Greek food, felt some coins and dipped their toes into hot sand, tried on clothes and listened to Greek music.

Maths: We have started working on fractions of shape and fractions of simple numbers this week. The children have learnt how to calculate shaded fractions and explored different ways of showing the same fraction. We have also been looking at division by grouping.
