We have been revising the rules of 'shun' sounding suffixes (tion, sion, ssion, cian). The spellings this week are:

Group 1: explanation, question, position, profession, musician, electrician, discussion, expansion, extension, confession

Group 2: action, reaction, mission, permission, explosion, tension, musician, decision

Judaism was the focus of this week's RE lesson; the children spent an afternoon learning about the Jewish Sabbath and creating Shabbat kits to teach other children about Jewish beliefs and practices and the importance of family life.



Tuesday is our SATRO Science day, please see the letter that came home tonight. The children will be building rockets and will need to bring in a 2-litre bottle for their experiment.

In English this week we learnt how to punctuate speech correctly, then the children made their own version of a Tin-Tin comic strip. Children worked together to create an interesting dialogue and then turned this into a story involving both speech and narrative.
