In Science we started the first of 3 exciting workshops on reflection, light and shadows, and electrical circuits. The children will complete the rotations next week.



During English lessons this week, the children have used their knowledge of planets and the solar system to create their own planet. The children had great fun creating exciting new life forms and plants. They then wrote a blurb for their story and added a glossary, which explained the technical and unusual words. The children wrote some lovely descriptive pieces, comparing their planets during daytime and night time.

In maths this week we looked at the link between fractions decimals and percentages. The children worked hard to demonstrate their skills in each area and the week culminated in a problem solving activity where the children answered questions related to fractions, decimals and percentages to crack the code.

This week we have been focused on comparatives and superlatives by adding the suffixes 'er' and 'est'.
