We have also drawn conclusions about the characters using information from the text.

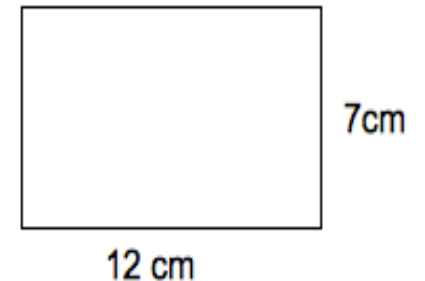
We have ended the week using their artistic skills to draw an image from the information given in the story.
