Writing Corner

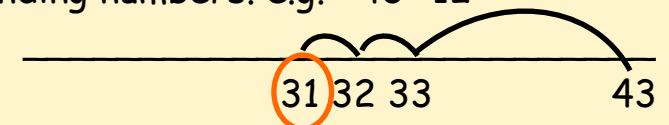
Have a go at writing an invitation to Max to come on your adventure. Explain to him why it would be fun, interesting or exciting.

Make sure you are using explanation words—*because, which, so ...*

Maths

The children have been learning the points of the compass, using directional language. Help them to practise pointing and turning to the North, South, East and West.

We have also been learning how to subtract using an empty number line by partitioning the number they are taking away into tens and units; Showing their steps and landing numbers. e.g. $43 - 12 =$



We are practising our number facts so that we can say what is 10 more or 10 less than any number.
