Here are two examples...

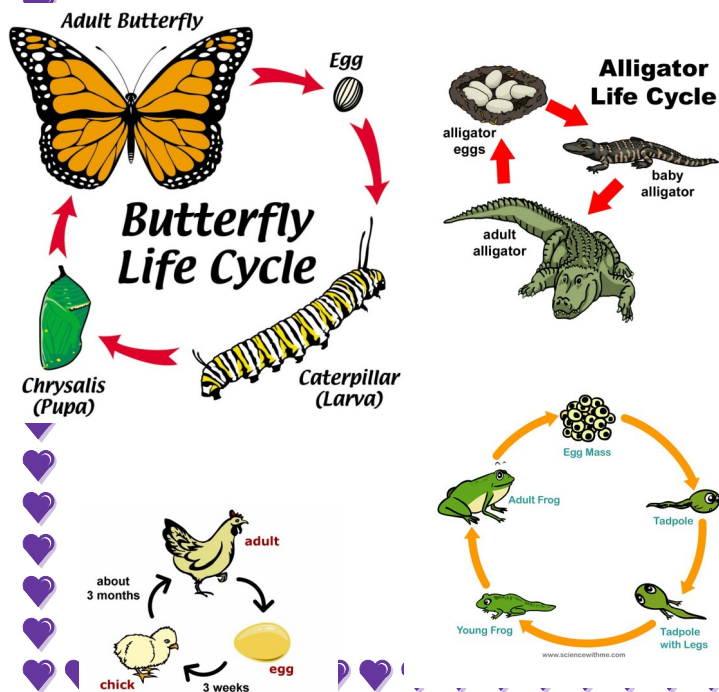
Add
