In maths this week, the children have been looking at percentages and learning simple ways of finding out how to find a percentage. We have given the children a percentage bubble sheet to help. Ask them to explain how to use them.

Please keep learning multiplication tables and practise the inverse too. Eg;

48 divided by 6 = 8

6 times 8 = 48
