Beech and Oak Class



We have also continued to practise sentence structure and our handwriting in our new writing books.

Maths

In maths this week we have been working with the number line to support our learning. We learnt the two symbols for greater than ($>$) and less than ($<$). We used the number lines to complete greater than and less than statements. We also revisited addition using number lines, we learnt the skill of counting on from the bigger number. Practising a range of maths using number lines is a great way for children to become confident with the order of numbers as well as the skill of counting on from any number. Please feel free to continue using number lines for addition at home.



RE

This week in RE we discussed what our basic needs are and what humans need in order to have a good wellbeing. We worked very nicely together in small groups to share and record our ideas.
