This week, please learn the words below. They are often misspelt because they have a silent 'u'.

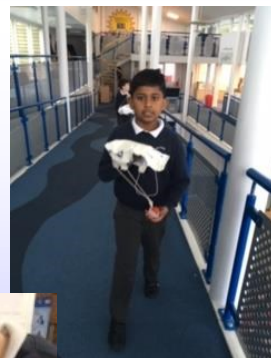
