

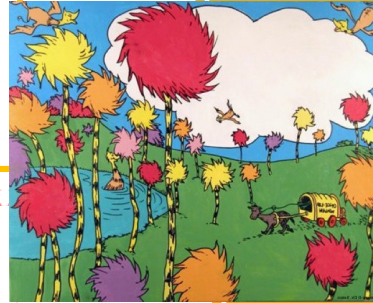

Dates for your diary:

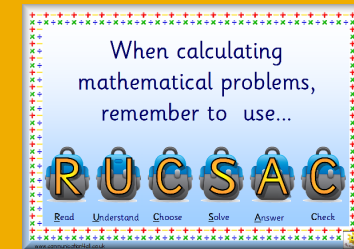
Please remember that there is no school on Monday 29th June.
