

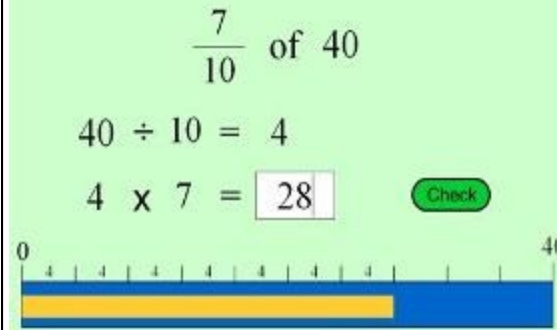
Just to let you know...

This week the children have planned and started to write their very own Viking adventure story. Why not ask your child what their main character is like, what the 'problem' in their story is and how it is resolved.

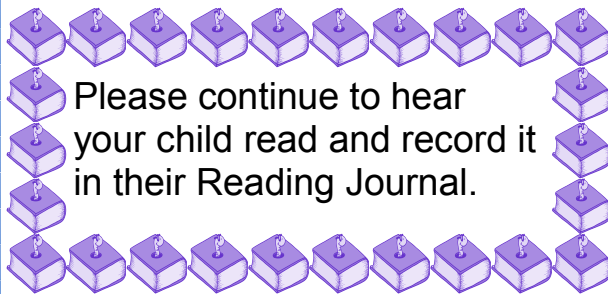


In Maths, the children have continued to find out about fractions. This week they have been learning how to calculate fractions of amounts and applied their knowledge to problem solving.
