Swimming will begin on Wednesday 13th April for 10 weeks.

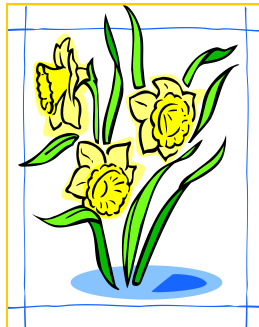
