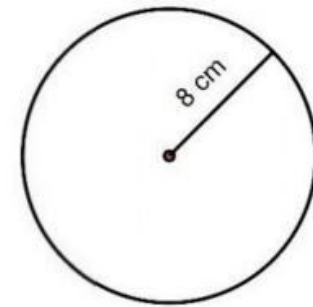

Maths

The children began the week looking at the properties of circles – focusing on diameter, radius and circumference. Can your child work out the diameter and (as an extra challenge) the circumference (using pi) of the circle below?



We then moved onto finding the volume of 3D shapes. Volume = length x breadth x height.
