We have really enjoyed learning about all kinds of patterns this week! The children have investigated repeating patterns both in maths and those that occur in our surroundings. We had a great walk to the Wild Place on Tuesday where we spotted lots of interesting patterns in buildings and walls. We made rubbings of trees and leaves and are making a beautiful collage with them.

We enjoyed reading the story of 'The Greedy Zebra' and practised writing sentences about this naughty beast with capital letters and full stops! When we had finished making repeating patterns in maths both inside and in the Rainbow Room we practised counting - by 'estimating' the number of spots on a leopard the children then checked by counting very carefully. At home see if your child can estimate how many pasta shapes/Lego pieces/teaspoons/sweets you put in front of them. See if they can count carefully to check!
