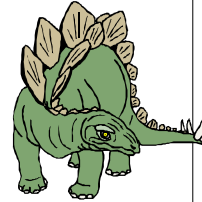
We have carried on with division this week and have also done some thinking about multiplying by 10. Tell mum or dad about big, mean zero.
