Jubilee Extravaganza

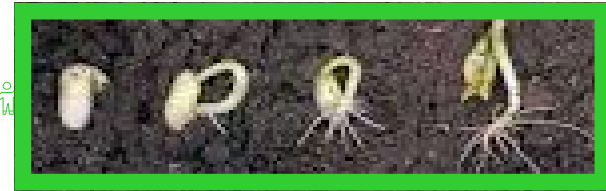
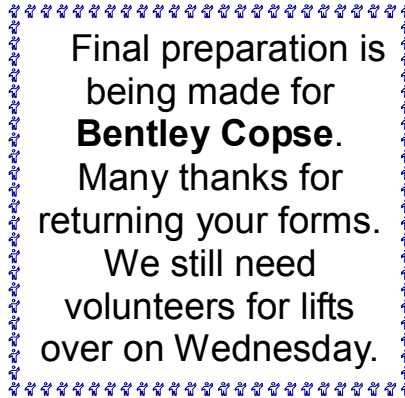

Final preparation is being made for Bentley Copse. Many thanks for returning your forms. We still need volunteers for lifts over on Wednesday.

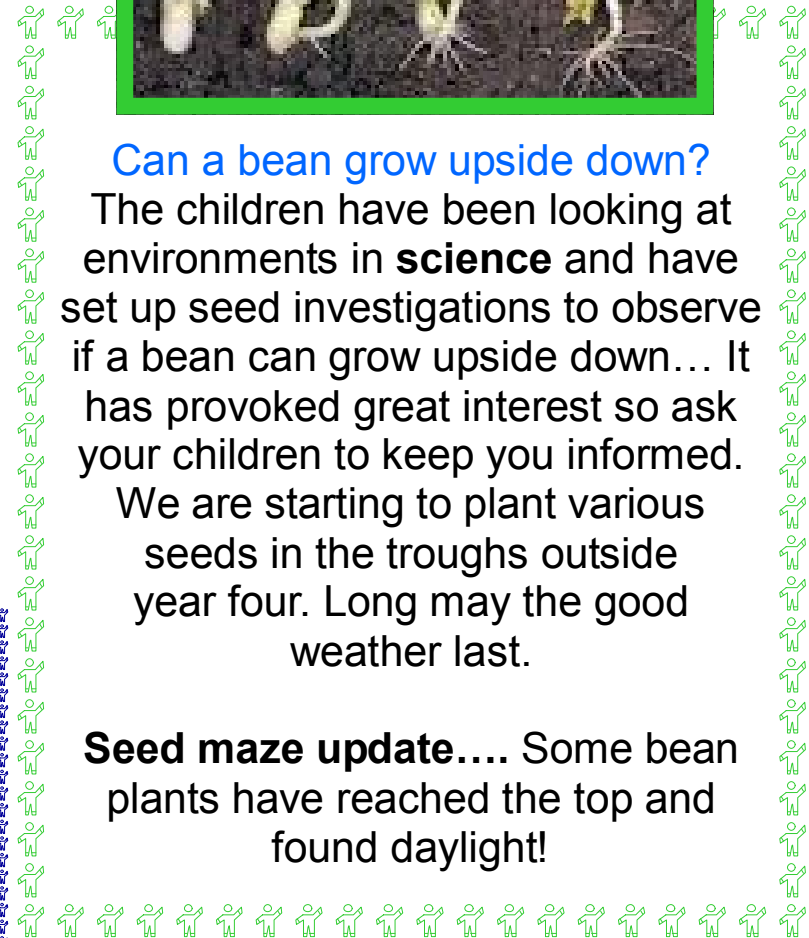


Can a bean grow upside down?
