We hope you have a fantastic weekend.

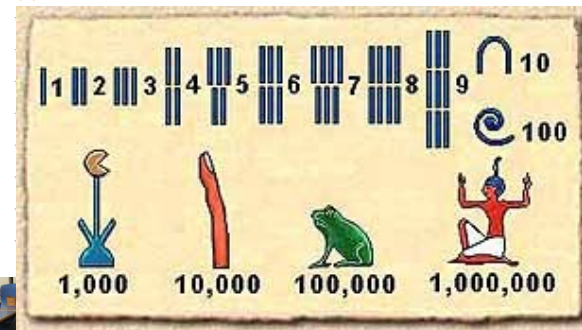
