LEAPS

The children's LEAPS projects have almost been completed this week; each child has become an expert on different aspects of Victorian life and they worked either individually or in pairs to present their work to others. We have been impressed by recipe books, fact files, posters, beautiful artwork and all the interactive ways the children have presented their work.

As an introduction to our Great Expedition the children have applied to be accepted by the Royal Society. They applied to be sent to one of the major industrial cities: Birmingham, Liverpool and Manchester and then learnt about what was cutting edge and unique about their city; looking at geographical advantages, trade, local resources and industrial impact.

We looked at the wonder that was The Great Exhibition and tried to imagine what it would've been like to have visited such an awe inspiring event. They found lots of great facts — ask your child what they found most fascinating about it.
