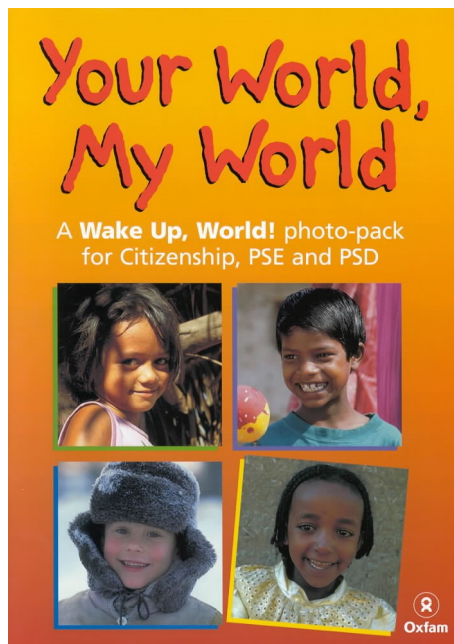


There is a new Wild Place sign up sheet outside the classrooms.
