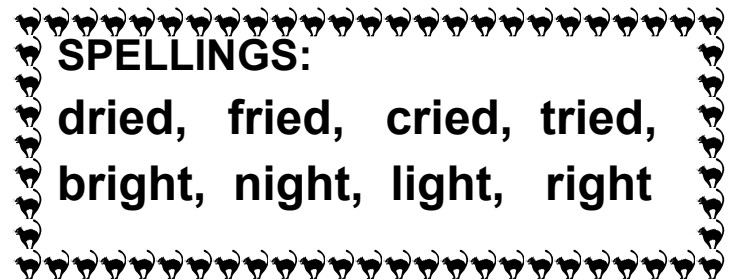
Science:
