

Maths

We have continued to work on addition this week and your children have looked at the range of ways you can write number sentences using the same three numbers. We have talked about fact families and how, for example, $10 = 9 + 1$ is the same as $1 + 9 = 10$. We used the part-part whole model again this week to discuss the parts of a whole number and how we can represent this in a number sentence. Why don't you ask your child to have a go at writing as many number sentences as they can for this:



Possible answers:
 $5 + 1 = 6$; $1 + 5 = 6$; $6 = 5 + 1$; $6 = 1 + 5$.
