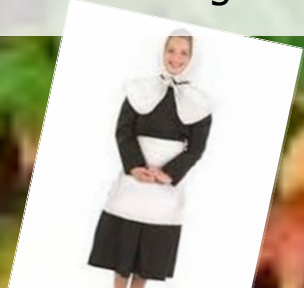


### Challenge Corner!
