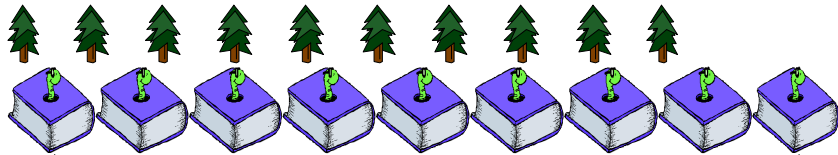




We've had fun this week dreaming up a holiday in the Amazon. The children are in the process of designing a brochure to advertise their stunning holiday destinations!

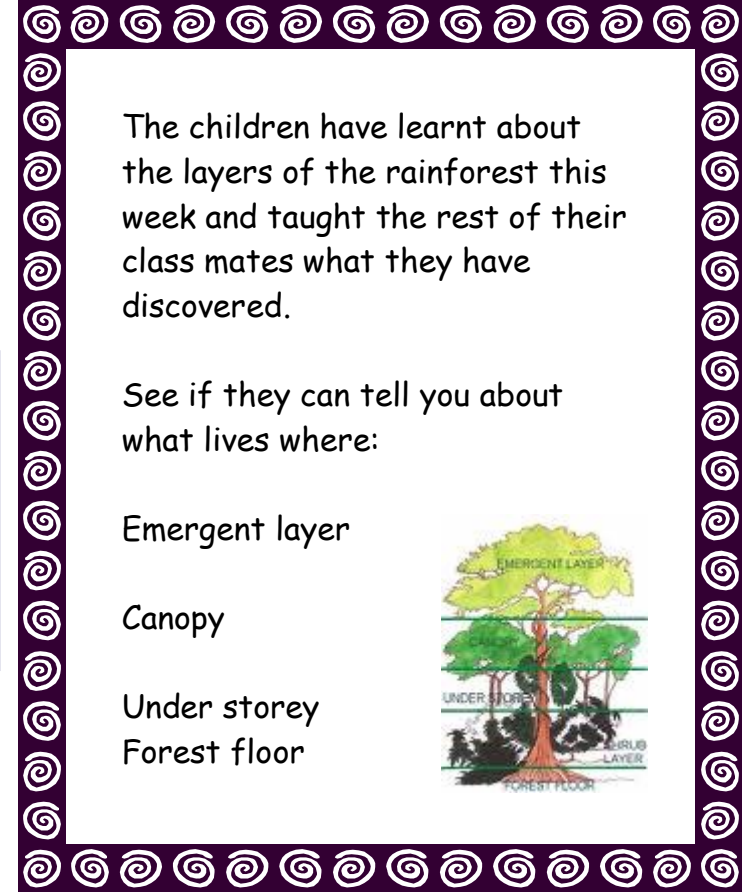
Dear Parents,

The children have learnt about the layers of the rainforest this week and taught the rest of their class mates what they have discovered.

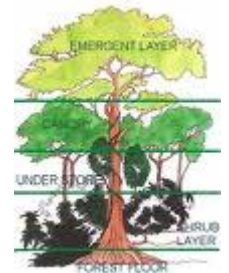
See if they can tell you about what lives where:
