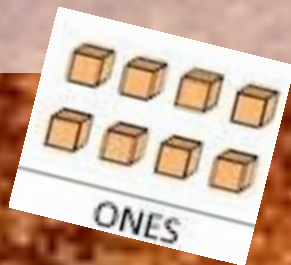
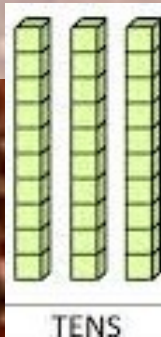


Maths focus
